  - 3. Apply and pay the \$60 application fee.
  - 4. Submit Materials (via your Cardinal Landing Portal)
  - 5. Check Your Status (via your Cardinal Landing Portal)

- Ball State University application:
  - Create login (use credentials you will remember!)
  - Choose level (graduate, first-time undergraduate, transfer, etc.)
  - Complete application
  - Pay the \$60 application fee.
  - Submit
- BUT WAIT! YOU'RE NOT DONE!
  - Use the credentials created above to login to your "Cardinal Landing Portal"
  - Submit required information (refer to your "checklist")





- Items of note:
  - English proficiency test scores or approved waiver is required for ALL applicants
  - GRADUATE applications require a credential evaluation completed by a NACES member
  - GRADUATE applications may have different deadlines from the standard deadlines

#### Standard deadlines:

- Fall (August start): 15 June
- Spring (January start): 15 November
- Summer (May start Graduate Programs only): 15 March





# **UG ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- Secondary school transcript (2.5 GPA)
- SAT/ACT are OPTIONAL
- Proof of Language Proficiency:
  - TOEFL 79
  - IELTS 6.5
  - PTE 53
  - Duolingo 110
  - SAT Reading & Writing 500
  - ACT English 21
  - Completion of 24 or more credit hours at an accredited U.S. university.

  - Proof of language proficiency:
    - TOEFL 79
    - IELTS 6.5
    - PTE 53
    - Duolingo 110
    - SAT Reading & Writing 500
    - ACT English 21
    - Completion of 24 or more credit hours at an accredited U.S. university.

# **FAST FACTS TO KNOW!**

- Ball State is test-optional: We do not require SAT or ACT for admission
- Essays or Personal Statements are not required for UG applications.
- We offer merit-based scholarships for UG students ranging from \$12,000-\$16,000.
- We offer Graduate Assistantships to help fund a graduate student's education.
- Ball State requires ALL applicants to submit language scores unless they qualify for a waiver.
- Graduate students MUST complete a NACES evaluation if their education was outside of the U.S.
- Ball State is a Division 1 school for athletics with the NCAA.
